What the changes are



We made some changes so the new **metro** can connect with other public transport services.



The **metro** is a new type of train.



We made a new timetable for trains.



The new timetable started on 20 October 2024.



There are changes to some bus services in areas outside of Sydney.



This is so they can connect with trains at the right time.

Changes to each train line

Liverpool and Inner West Line



This change is about trains on the Liverpool and Inner West Line.



The trains on this line used to used to go from Liverpool to the city through Bankstown.

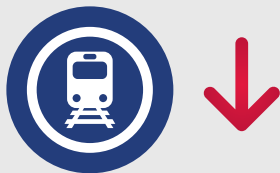


The trains will now go through Regents Park and Lidcombe to get to the city.

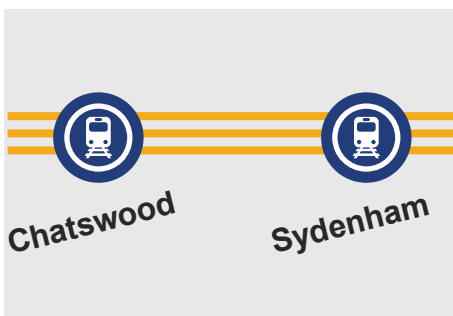
North Shore Line



This change is about trains on the North Shore Line.



There will be less train services on the North Shore Line between Chatswood and the city.



There are new metro trains that go between Chatswood and Sydenham.



This makes it easier for people to get trains between Chatswood and Sydney CBD.

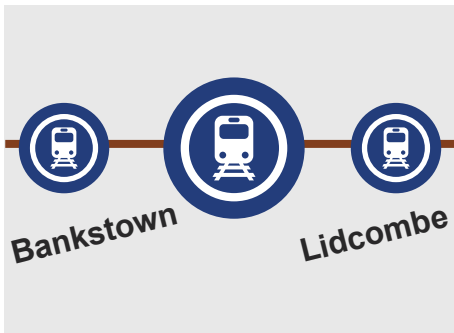


There are also more trains between Berowra and Hornsby.

New Lidcombe and Bankstown Line



This change is about trains on the Lidcombe and Bankstown line.

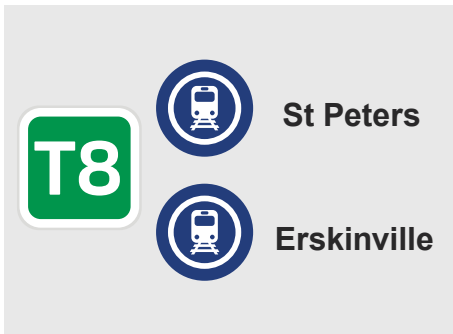


There is a new train that goes between Bankstown and Lidcombe



Regents Park is now where people change trains between Bankstown and Liverpool.

Erskineville and St Peters trains



You can still catch trains on the T8 Line at St Peters and Erskineville.



Trains still go straight to the city.

This change is for the Cumberland Line.

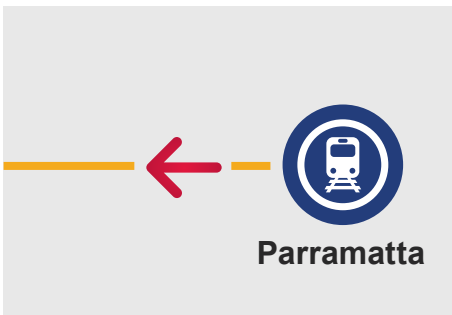


There is now a train every 15 minutes in the busy morning times.

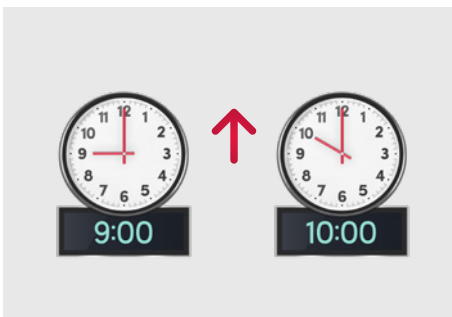
Western Line



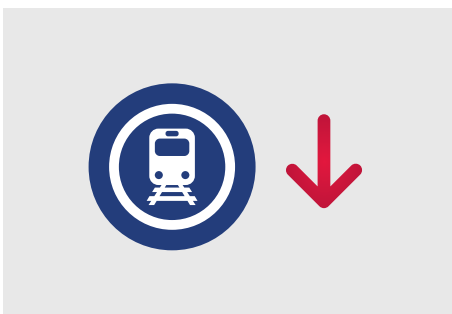
This change is about trains on the Western Line.

This change is for the Leppington and Inner West Line.

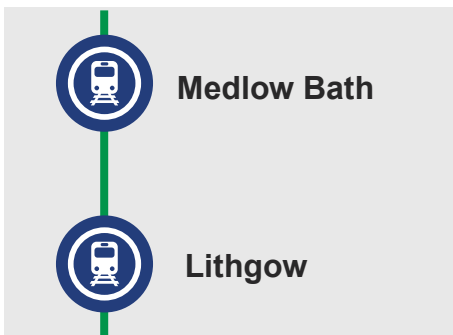


There are small changes to the times when trains come.

There are now more trains between Medlow Bath and Lithgow.

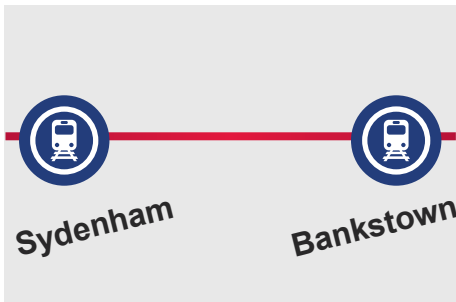


There are some changes to the times the trains come.

It will help people get where they need to go until the Metro is built.

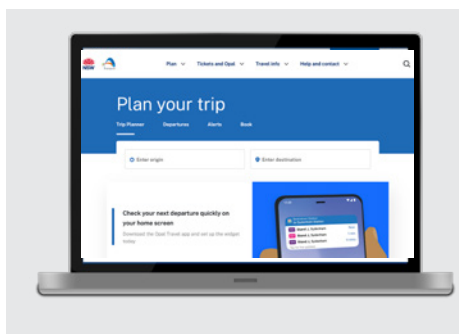


This change might go until September 2025.

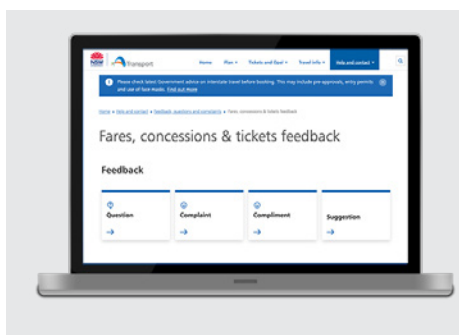
